DOGS.

V.D. 9-3a 1. Brewer & Moody's Sultair The Sea Baron at Bowfort. B/T belying his 10 years. Very attentive and alert. Coat and pigment a good colour. A pleasing shape and moved out strongly still driving around the ring. Nice round, dark eyes giving a soft expression.

2. Dix's Beewye Lara's Rufus. A little younger than 1 at 8 yrs but again a lovely colour to coat. Nice short hocks & good turn of stifle. Lovely head with a soft gentle expression. Just preferred the overall shape of 1.

3. Steel's Charlmray Royal Sovereign of Behabre.

M.P.D. 8-2a 1. Allerton's Deeriem Trumpet Man Blen puppy who looks just as he should at 8 mths. A quality puppy throughout. Good neck & shoulders level topline & good tail carriage showing to advantage on the move. Soft expression with dark round eyes and jet black pigment.

2. Levy & Sedgwick's Pascavale Phoenix. Again just a baby at 7 mths. A fuller head than 1 with well placed ears dark eyes and a clean face giving a lovely expression. A small chunky body but he lost his shape on the move with a tendency to roll.

Hopefully as he matures this will correct itself.

3. Sedgbeer's Jack Junior.

P.D. 6-0a Pagan's Russmic Reggae Music at Sorata. For me my find of the day. This B/T puppy is just gorgeous in every way. Bright tan markings on a raven black coat. His head is masculine but not exaggerated. Dark round eyes, well tapered muzzle with not too deep stop and a good scissor bite with strong teeth. Good neck & shoulders lead into a level topline short coupling and lovely stifles. He drove round the ring as though he owned it. Wish he was mine. **BPD BPIS.**

2. Vella's Cinderlace Cromwell. A well presented Blen of 9 mths. Very eye catching. His ears framed a well cushioned face with good dark pigment. Sufficient neck and good lay of shoulder. He moved with drive keeping his shape and showing off his good angulations and tail set.

3. Li's Avalcier Nemesis.

J.D. 5-1a Pagan's Lewisile Highland Stewart. Another lovely B/T. Similar to my puppy winner. Lovely tan again. Gentle expression from dark round eyes & well tapered muzzle & well feathered ears. Slightly arched neck & well laid shoulders with a good spring of rib and nice bone made a lovely picture both standing and on the

move. His black coat was gleaming and well presented as were all the dogs from this kennel. **RBD.**

2. Allerton & Brewer's Bowfort Rouge Avec Deeriem. A ruby puppy slightly larger than 1 but still balanced. Soft head framed with well placed ears. He kept a good shape on the move as well as standing. His coat not looking the best colour but the lights in the hall not doing any favours for this colour.

3. Allitt's Tillasby Razzle Dazzle.

N.D.4-0a. 1. Pagan's Sorata Bob Marley. This ruby is the father to my best puppy. Another quality exhibit. Well off for coat of a good colour & texture. A shapely body with lovely bone moving freely and positive. A very pleasing head.

2. Connell's Monaric Moonlight Shadow. B/T on larger lines than 1. Good coat colour & pigment. He held a good shape on the move and used his tail the whole time.

3. Richmond's Charlottetown Pieter.

G.D.5-3a. 1. Hubbard's Popalulu Dazzling Dempster. A handsome Blen dog. Very eye catching. Well constructed and a good type. Moved round the ring with drive and was on his toes the whole time.

2. Allerton's Deeriem Dandi Man. 20mth old lightly marked Blen. Correct size with good rear angulation. Pleasing head. Close decision between these two.

P.G.D.2-0a. 1. Biddle's Hearthfriend Haute Couture. A well marked tri with good tan. Dark round eyes, good pigment. Well put together allowing him to move freely around the ring. In good coat.

2. Dix's Beewye Millies Red Robin. Ruby dog which was hard to assess. Very un-cooperative for handler and refused to walk in a straight line for more than 2 steps. Lovely rich coat of good texture. A full head and good bone, slightly longer cast than 1.

SP. L. BLEN OR TRI. 4-0a 1. Biddle's Hearthfriend Haute Couture.

2. Richmond's Charlottetown Pieter. Well marked tri. Alert expression using his ears well. Short coupled, moved well.

3. Latteck's Pascavale Mikie.

SP. L. B/T or R. 1. Pagan's Campanards Tribute to Sorata. Up to size ruby. Very expressive eyes and used his ears well. Fabulous condition, good muscle tone & lovely coat. Moved freely.

2. Allerton & Brewers Bowfort Rouge Avec Deeriem.

3. North & Box Jalesto Now I'm Here.

O.D. 7-0a. 1. Allerton's Cazarrah Tennyson for Deeriem. Attractively marked Blen. Lovely head with dark eyes & soft expression. His pigment was exceptional. Well balanced and moved true. Finished off with a good coat making a very eye-catching picture. **BD RBIS.**

2. Waller's Castlewytch Arizona Avec Jinjan. 4yr old Blen. Very well presented masculine headed dog in good condition. Not as eye-catching as 1 but lovely to go over. He moved strongly and stood 4 square. At one with his handler.

3. Wileman & Bott's Lymery High Jack at Narvidar.

SP O. Bred by EXH. 2-0a 1. Biddle's Hearthfriend Haute Couture.

2. Peck's Valanroy Casanova Lad. Well marked Blen. Nice head with dark eyes. Cushioned muzzle, short coupled & moved OK.

BITCHES

V.B. 3-0a 1. Salisbury's Clopsville Sherry. Almost 8yr old B/T showing like a youngster. Excelled in neck & shoulders. Lovely level topline at all times. Moved with drive and clearly enjoying her return to the show ring. **BV**.
2. Flowers Anberan Iced Cappuccino. 8yr old who again could show some youngsters how it's done. Pleasing head, good body standing four square.
3. Connells Monaric Ray of Light.

M.P.B. 8-4a. 1. Steel's Behabre Anais Anais. Just a baby but this b/t shows lot of promise. Pretty head with lovely dark eyes. Good reach of neck and nice size.
2. Loades Mia Leah Ericanna Rosirius Blen of just 7 mths, another who needs time but showing the promise of things to come. Richly marked and good pigment. A lovely shape.
3. Repton's Crystaldawn Miss Muffet.

P.B. 12-3a 1. Goodwin's Lanola Sabrosa. 10mth richly marked Blen. Pretty head with dark eyes & pigment. Lovely neck, level topline and correct tail set. Moved with drive from good hindquarters. A lovely picture.
2. Li's Avalcier Nadine. Another very nice puppy presented in good condition. Pretty head, with soft expression. Not quite as balanced as 1.
3. Sedgbeer's Scarlet Rose.

J.B. 14-6a 1. Martin's Titian Summerberry. Lovely bodied ruby with good bone & well sprung ribs. Nice turn of stifles, short hocks moving with drive. Lovely shape when standing.
2. Payne's Catemmsal Serenade. Very similar to 1. Very pretty head well set ears & round eyes. Lovely size.
3. Robertson's Barenton Masquerade.

N.B. 12-3a 1. Taylor's Kemble Nikita. Very pretty headed B/T. Correct length of muzzle & good pigment. Level topline with correct tail set. Good stifles & moved with drive.
2. Martin's Titian Luisette Good coloured ruby with good fore chest, neck & shoulders. Lovely bone.
3. Salisbury's Clopsville Carmarillo.

G.B. 12-4a 1. Taylor's Kemble Charisma. I liked the shape of this b/t, she was short in back and nicely balanced. Good topline and correct tail set which never went any higher than her back. Pretty head & dark pigment.

2. Goodwin's Lanola Move Over Darling. Nice head with good pigment. Well broken coat in lovely condition. Not moving as good as 1 today.
3. Sparrow's Tashmit The Next Generation.

P.G.B. 7-2a 1. Li's Avalcier Sakura Well broken Blen. Attractively marked. Pretty head with soft expression. Lovely size & shape, keeping a level topline on the move.
2. Steel's Behabre Mitsouku B/T good head with soft expression. Nice neck & shoulders and rear angulation.
3. Flowers Anberan Tazoberry.

S.L. Blen or Tri. 5-1a 1. Biddle's Hearthfriend Home Alone. Lightly marked Blen with pretty head, Short level back and good tail set. Plenty of silky coat.
2. Skinner's Khatibi Gladys All Over at Rahmzi. Heavily marked Tri. Good pigment, level topline and correct tail set.
3. Vout's Touvas Magic Charm.

S.L. B/T or R. 11-2a 1. Payne's Catemmsal Party Doll. B/T Lovely head with rich tan markings. Good front, neck & shoulders. Level topline & moved well.
2. Flower's Anberan Ginger Truffle. Ruby with pleasing head, good spring of rib, nice bone and moved OK.
3. Robertson's Barenton Morning Glory.

O.B. 2-0a. 1. Goodwin's Lanola Serafina. Attractively marked Tri with plenty of coat. Short coupled with well sprung ribs. Lovely head dark round eyes well set ears & good pigment. Nice overall balance.
2. Vout's Magic Charm. Blen. Nice bone, well ribbed & good tail carriage.

Sp. O. Bred by Exh. 3-0a. 1. Levy & Sedgwick's Pascavale Clarrisa. A very pretty bitch. Melting expression with good dark pigment. Lovely long framing ears, set well. Nicely marked coat in pristine condition. Lovely shape both standing and on the move. Well schooled, never put a foot wrong. **BB, BIS.**
2. Biddle's Hearthfriend Home Alone
3. Power's Allourone Black Beauty.

Sp. O. Stakes D. or B. 4-3a. 1. Sedgbeer's Scarlet Rose. Ruby bitch, 3rd in puppy. Good head, dark pigment, nice outline. Just needs time to mature.
